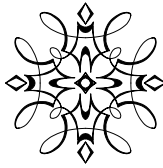

Last Sunday we celebrated the RCIA Rite of Election and entered three Catechumens into the Book of the Elect to prepare the way for their reception of the Easter Sacraments. There will also be four children from the RCIC program baptized at Easter. Several others will be received and receiving the sacraments of Eucharist, Reconciliation and Confirmation. We are so deeply blessed as a community to celebrate the new life that the RCIA program brings to remind us all of the wonder and holiness of the Church in its sacramental life. We want to thank Liam Ferrar and Doreen Wan for their assistance with the Friars in this holy process of Sacramental preparation and celebration. Please continue to pray for our catechumens and those who are a part of the RCIA and RCIC programs. They bring blessing and life to the whole community. Next Sunday the 3rd Sunday of Lent and the two that follow we will be celebrating the Rites of Scrutiny for the Catechumens. As a result we will be using the readings from John's gospel from the lectionary Cycle A for those three weeks instead of the Current Cycle C readings from St. Luke. Whenever we have catechumens with whom we celebrate the rites of Scrutiny we remain with John's gospel. These options are pointed out in your misalettes so you can follow them.

Thank you all for your participation in the Lenten exercises offered by the parish. Each Friday after the 5:30 mass a different parish organization or group leads the Stations of the Cross. Please see the bulletin to see which group is responsible to lead this prayerful devotion. On the First Friday of April, we will have the anointing of the sick followed by the Stations of the Cross in place of the usual Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament. Benediction will resume on the first Friday of May. The Lenten Soup night is being promoted as the way we share in the disciplines of Prayer Fasting and Almsgiving as a parish and also sponsor the Winter Welcome Table outreach that we support with St. Peter's Parish. A special thank you to Dominic and Maria Caprara for their efforts in making this evening so special and to all of you who sign up for this program, Thank you!

This coming Tuesday, we will celebrate St. Patrick's Day and St. Joseph's Day with the seniors at the Merrymakers Mass and Luncheon in the parish hall. Thank you to Louis Gris for his generosity in preparing this meal and to all the seniors who gather to share fellowship and festivity even in the middle of the Lenten season. What a joy it is to see you all together sharing fun and fellowship.

The final touches on the 100th anniversary book are being made, and special posters have been designed and are being printed for display in the Church as we near the celebration. Thank you to all who are working so diligently to complete this process. Grace Horvatin, Larry O'Grady and Cathi Richardson are spearheading the efforts. Thank you to all. We have ordered a Presider's Chair for the sanctuary and this should be ready for Easter. We also hope to put the finishing touches on the new carpet, floor and stair preparations for the balcony. Thank you all for your very generous donations to make these improvements possible. Special thanks also to the members of the building committee who have furthered the efforts of the carpets and floors each week, kept the boilers and safety systems up to date and running. Barry Carolyn and Ivan Kastelic bring leadership to this wonderful group whose dedication,

and fellowship is truly a gift to our parish.

As we continue on our Lenten Journey, let us ask the Holy Spirit to continue to guide and protect us as we follow in the footsteps of the Lord Jesus Christ to the Paschal Celebrations at Easter time.
