

THE PASTOR'S CORNER

Peace and Goodness to all!

Share Life, the annual appeal to sponsor the Charities supported by the Archdiocese of Toronto has begun. Maggie Bruneau, one of our parishioners addressed three of our masses last weekend to help us understand the depth and scope of services that are made possible through this effort. Thank you for your generosity in this effort. One very interesting aspect of this year's appeal is that whatever increase we make in giving to this, will be matched by a wealthy benefactor. On behalf of the Friars, I personally increased our donation and I hope you will do the same. Our Parish goal this year is 57,000 dollars, and with God's grace and your donations we will meet or surpass our assigned goal. Thank you for the sacrificial giving that will make our meeting this goal possible.

Tuesday evening the Finance Committee met to review our parish finances and to address the personnel needs of the parish. The committee continues in the search to find the right person to handle the weekly accounting and annual reporting duties for the parish, and they are interviewing candidates in the process. Their oversight and advice is an invaluable resource for the parish and I am deeply grateful to each and all of them for their service to the parish. Let us pray that God will send the right person to serve our needs for good ministry and service to the parish. The committee will present the annual report to all of the mass congregations the week after Easter. May God continue to bless the good work they do for us.

The Parish Council also gathered on Tuesday evening to report on the activities of the various ministries and committees of the parish. I am deeply grateful to all for the ongoing stewardship of the parish that continues through the many organizations that you foster. One important issue that was discussed involves the security and safety of the community regarding evacuation in the case of an emergency. These matters are well addressed for the Children in religious education. Organization and safety issues for the whole congregation are now being arranged and will be addressed in the coming weeks.

Wednesday, after the funeral in the morning, I went to Our Lady Queen of Apostles Retreat Center for the Lenten day of prayer for priests of the Archdiocese. It is an opportunity for the priests to pray, go to confession and spend some time in fellowship with one another to prepare for the Easter celebrations. Fr. Mladen was there and asked me to say hello to all. It was a lovely day and you were all in my prayers. I hope you will take some time during this Lenten season to reflect on what we are about to celebrate in Passion Week and Easter time.

Thursday evening we gathered to finalize the album for the Parish Pictorial directory. It is a wrap as they would say in the television or motion picture industry. Now it is up to the Life Touch Company to complete our book. They said it would be at least three months before they could have it completed, so we hope that by the summer or at the latest by the autumn we will have our new picture book available for distribution. Let us pray for its completion. Thank you for your patience in this long process. I have heard from other pastors that it usually takes more than a year to complete the process, so that makes me feel a little better.

As ever it has been a busy week, and by God's grace we continue to make progress through this Lenten journey to the eternal Jerusalem. I am ever grateful to all of you for your dedication and support of the parish may the Lord continue to send us the Holy Spirit to guide and protect us on the journey.
