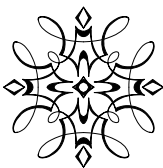

THE PASTOR'S CORNER
Peace and Goodness to all!

Before the liturgical renewal of the Church of Vatican II, the fifth Sunday in Lent was called Passion Sunday. This marked the beginning of the two week period of concentrated focus in the liturgies on the death of the Lord and led through Palm Sunday to the Holy Week celebrations. Now we call Palm Sunday Passion Sunday.

On the 5th Sunday of Lent, we continue to direct our focus on the passion of the Lord in liturgical readings, the use of the preface for the Passion, and some changes in the liturgical decoration of the Church. Here at St. Joan of Arc the statues will all be removed (it's also a good time to clean them) the baptismal font will be draped in purple and the altar cloths will be changed to more dramatically depict the season. In some churches all of the statues are covered in purple cloth. The readings through out the week will focus more directly on the passion of the Lord as we concentrate our prayers in preparation for the Holy Week celebrations that will follow from Passion (Palm) Sunday. The statues will not be returned until the Easter Vigil celebration. The covering or removal of the statuary was always meant to focus our attention in worship to the Pascal Mysteries we will celebrate most solemnly in the Easter Triduum. That is Holy Thursday, Good Friday and the Easter Vigil. In Some main line Protestant Churches, the Passiontide continues to be celebrated as a part of their liturgical tradition.

The 5th Sunday will also mark the 3rd and final rite of the Scrutinies for the Catechumens, hence we will continue the use of Cycle A with the story of the raising of Lazarus from John's Gospel. These final two weeks of lent have always been and continue to be a time for us to intensify our prayer and concentration on the love of God poured out in the passion and death of the Lord. Let us ask the Holy Spirit to bless our parish in this time so we may truly celebrate these most holy days and all they mean for the life of the Church.
