# The Pastor's Corner Peace and Goodness to All!

This third Sunday of Lent we will pray the first of three Scrutiny prayers for our Catechumens as they prepare for their baptism at Easter. This year we anticipate two or three baptisms at the Easter Vigil and 4 persons are preparing for reception into full communion with the Catholic Church. Let us keep these individuals in our prayers especially in this holy time of Lent.

The disciplines of prayer fasting and almsgiving are united as one means to grow in openness to God's gracious mercy and love. In our fasting we experience physical hunger which can remind us of our spiritual hunger for God so that it enhances our prayer and our awareness for the need, "to pray always and never loose heart" as St. Paul encourages. By fasting we also reduce our spending on material food and goods, so we can save resources to give them to others in alms and charity. As a parish we are encouraged to do this together through our Lenten Soup Night program. There are pages in the back of the Church that explain this program for the community to pray, fast and give alms to the poor together. Additionally, in the back of the Church after all of the Sunday Masses, there are members of the St. Vincent de Paul Society who faithfully hold the "poor box" to collect money for the families and individuals they serve in our own parish. This year two of the most generous donors to the society have died, leaving a major deficit in the funds they use to care for these families and individuals. They have had to petition their downtown office to supplement their funds. Please remember the St. Vincent de Paul Charity as you leave Church. Their care is direct and hands on service to those in our midst who need care.

At our staff meeting this week we discussed and planned the annual Lenten Ministries Retreat. This will convene on Saturday March 25, which is the feast of the Annunciation. As we remember the day that Mary engaged in the dialogue with the angel of the Lord and spoke her response, "Let it be done to me according to your Word" we pray that we too may be open to God's word and plan for our parish, so that we will know and do God's will at all times. We encourage all of our ministers to attend and participate in this important retreat so we will be well prepared to celebrate the Pascal feasts of Holy Week and Easter. Thank you for planning to be there from 10:AM through 12 Noon on March 25th.

On Friday of this week, the purple turned to GREEN all over the place! It must have been those pesky leprechauns. They interrupted our Lenten time with festivities of Irish songs and jocularity all over the place! The odors of Corned Beef and cabbage filled the air and on a Friday! They told me there was a lilt of Irish laughter all over the neighborhood and some even heard the angels singing Happy St. Patrick's day!

On a given night, 6,000 people across Canada between 16 and 24 have nowhere to call home. This represents 20 per cent of the total homeless population. In Toronto, estimates of homeless youth range from 900 to 2,000 nightly.

The ShareLife—supported Rights of Passage program at Covenant House have been active in making a positive difference in the lives of homeless youth on the streets of Toronto. 75 % of these youth have been matched with mentors and have also made progress in strengthening their life skills and family relationships, getting them ready for life on their own. In addition, the ShareLife funded Youth In Transition programs helps youth in foster care to transition to independent living. Sunday April 2, 2017 is ShareLife Sunday
