MARDI GRAS PANCAKE SUPPER

Next Tuesday, is Pancake Tuesday, and our Confirmandi will once again be serving up dinner to the parish community, doors open at 5:30 pm.. Everyone is welcome! Adults \$7.00, children \$5.00, Families \$20.00

ASH WEDNESDAY, March 5

This is one of the two days in the church year (the other is Good Friday) when healthy persons between the ages of 18 and 59 are asked to observe a day of fast and abstinence. This consists of having one full meal (with no meat) and up to two other meals which, taken together, do not equal the full meal; no snacks in between and no meat at any meal. We are asked to be sensible with regard to specific conditions. A construction worker, a person with diabetes or a nursing mother would not be expected to rigidly follow this precept. Observance of it is the church's way of helping us to be aware that we are entering a time of a more sombre preparation of our hearts for the full celebration of the Paschal Mystery at Easter. Abstinence on the other Fridays of Lent is a matter of personal, voluntary discipline, recommended but not required by church precept. If we are not abstaining, we should be replacing it with some other personal discipline.

This year the service will be at Humbercrest United Church at Baby Point Rd. (w. of Jane St.) Saturday, March 8th at 10:00 a.m.. This year Egypt is the focus of the prayer service. St. Joan of Arc is one of 7 local Churches participating. Light refreshments. All invited.
