

ST. JOSEPH Feast Day March 19th (INFO FROM SAINTS & ANGELS - CATHOLIC ON LINE)

St. Joseph's feast day is March 19<sup>th</sup>, that is easy to remember, right after St. Patrick's Day. The Irish make a big deal of March 17<sup>th</sup>, maybe the Canadians should make a fuss over St. Joseph's Day. After all he is the Patron Saint of Canada, as well as the Universal Church.

What do we know about St. Joseph? He was the husband of Mary and the foster father to Jesus. We know this through the Bible. Joseph was a hard working carpenter, despite his humble work, as well we learned from the gospel that Joseph was a descendant of David.

Joseph was a man of his faith and obedient to whatever God asked of him. When told to travel to protect his family, he did so each time without question. We know that Joseph loved Jesus; he showed that in his care for his foster Son. He worried about His safety after all he had been entrusted to care for Him. When He went missing, Joseph travelled back to the temple when they found Him after three days of searching.

Did you know that there are two feast days in honour of St. Joseph? March 19 is for St. Joseph the husband of Mary and May 1 for St. Joseph the Worker.

#### A Prayer to St. Joseph

Oh, St. Joseph, whose protection is so great, so strong, so prompt before the throne of God, I place in you all my interest and desires. Oh, St. Joseph, do assist me by your powerful intercession, and obtain for me from your divine Son all spiritual blessings, through Jesus Christ, our Lord. So that, having engaged here below your heavenly power, I may offer my thanksgiving and homage to the most loving of Fathers. Oh, St. Joseph, I never weary contemplating you, and Jesus asleep in your arms; I dare not approach while He reposes near your heart. Press Him close in my name and kiss His fine head for me and ask Him to return the Kiss when I draw my dying breath. St. Joseph, Patron of departing souls - Pray for me.

This prayer was found in the fiftieth year of Our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. In 1505 it was sent from the Pope to Emperor Charles when he was going into battle. Whoever shall read this prayer or hear it or keep it about themselves, shall never die a sudden death, or be drowned, nor shall poison take effect on them; neither shall they fall into the hands of the enemy, or shall be burned in any fire or shall be overpowered in battle.

#### Japan Earthquake/Tsunami Relief March 11, 2011

Caritas International, the Catholic Church's official international relief organization, issued a statement to the global members of the Caritas network indicating that no emergency appeal has been issued at this time. At present, Caritas Japan has not requested assistance. Should this situation change, we will be kept informed.

The Archdiocese has learned that there is a desire across our Archdiocese to make contributions to relief efforts in solidarity with the people of Japan. To assist this process, Sharelife is willing to accept donations from parishes, where the parishioners wish to support the relief efforts.

If you wish to support these efforts, Sharelife asks that you **do not** use Sharelife envelopes. They ask that you use plain envelopes, so not to be confused with the 2011 Sharelife Appeal which has started. Please mark your name and amount on the envelopes, along with you offertory envelope number, so you get credit on your tax receipt. Please mark the envelopes "*Relief for Japan*". Cheques should be made payable to the St. Joan of Arc-Sharelife and marked Earthquake relief. The parish will then forward one cheque to the Sharelife office.
