Society of St. Vincent de Paul

I am taking advantage of Fr. Bob's absence to ask for your support of the work, we do to help our neighbours in need. Also, giving you information about the Society.

At the Parish Level: Home visitations are conducted by over 1,200 volunteer members of the society of St. Vincent de Paul, assisting 16,000 families and individuals each year with emergency food, clothing and beds. Parish based conferences of volunteer members- or- "Vincentians" – also conduct annual Christmas Programmes and assist in financing Special Works of the Society. (In the Archdiocese of Toronto.)

Mary Grove Camp: A full subsidized residential camping program for 1200 girls aged 5-13, located on Georgian Bay near Penetang.

Stores & Distribution Centre: Items, are provide for free of charge to those in need through a voucher system in our stores. Goods are also available to walk-in customers at low cost. Donations are collected through the parish Bundle Weekends.

Prison Apostolate & Court Services: Provides support and clothing for persons in prison or awaiting a trial and assists them in maintaining contact with their families.

Twinning: A partnership offering aid to needy Conferences and councils in Canada and over seas.

Gower Park Place: Operated by the Vincent Paul Family Homes Corporation. Gower Park Place is a non profit 164 unit affordable apartment building in the East York.

Residential Housing Programs

Women's Emergency and Transitional Housing Programs- Providing housing and support to women in crisis through a network of emergency beds and long-term housing at Mary's Home. Amelie House, St. Clare's Residence and Elisa House. 128 Women receive secure housing and support each night with on going assistance provide to women fleeing domestic abuse.

St. Francis Residence: a home for 24 men and women who have experience mental illness and are dependant on others for support. Our aim is to help increase the quality of their lives and hasten a return to self-sufficiency.

Ozanam House: Provides transitional accommodation and support for men recently discharged from a detoxification unit and waiting entry into an addiction treatment program. This home provides a caring and supportive residence for 12 men.

Let's go back to the parish level of help. Here at St. Joan of Arc, we help about 80 families throughout the year. Giving out food vouchers to families that could be a single person up to a family of 7 people. We need your help to continue this work. A few years ago, we approached Fr. During the pandemic poor box donations dropped drastically. If you use our blue envelopes and put your information on them, we will issue you a tax receipt at the end of the year. Call for Catechists for 2022-2023

Have you ever thought of sharing your faith with the younger generation of our parish? The Office of Religious Education at St. Joan of Arc is looking for people willing to continue telling Christ's story. We will have a number of meetings to talk about what it takes and the training that we will provide.

As Pope Francis has said, "Rivers of blood and tears are flowing in Ukraine. It is not merely a military operation, but a war, which sows death, destruction and misery." (March 6, 2022)

We are watching the unfolding of one of the great population displacements of modern history. And we, as people blessed to live in a peaceful and wealthy country like Canada, are witnessing that crisis. In the Gospel of Matthew, Jesus Christ lets us know what will be on the "final exam" on judgement day. Did we feed the hungry, clothe the naked and shelter the homeless? During this time of Lent, when we engage in activities such as prayer, fasting and almsgiving, we are called to remember the people of Ukraine. The Archdiocese of Toronto has begun a call for financial support for the humanitarian crisis in Ukraine, both in directly supporting agencies on the ground in Ukraine, but also in preparing to welcome the many refugees who are already beginning to arrive from that ravaged country. If you would like to support this endeavour, you can make donations through your parish. Make cheques payable to St Joan of Arc and on the memo line print Ukraine relief. This will be added to your parish donations and included on your tax receipt at the end of the year.


