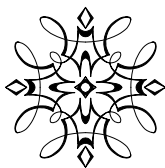

This Sunday we will celebrate the first of the three rites of Scrutiny for our catechumen candidates for adult baptism from the RCIA program. These rites will be celebrated at the 10:00 AM mass this week, the 12:00 noon mass next week and the 10:00AM mass on the 5th week of lent. All of the weekend liturgies will involve the lectionary readings from Cycle A for these three weeks in solidarity with those who will be receiving the Easter Sacraments. We are deeply grateful to God for sending so many to participate in our RCIA program which signifies new life and new beginnings for our life in Christ as a community.

Our youth group gathered as usual on Monday evening. This group is planning to serve our Sunday worship on the first week of April as lectors, greeters, ministers and servers for our gathering to worship.
