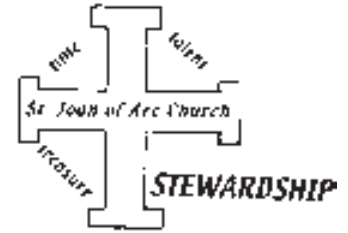

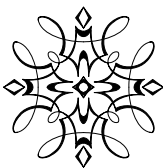

THE PASTOR'S CORNER

Peace and All Goodness!

This, the third Sunday of lent we will celebrate the first of the three Scrutinies in the Rite of Christian Initiation Liturgical process that concludes at Easter. This first scrutiny will take place today during the 12:00 Noon liturgy. Next week we will celebrate the second scrutiny at the 10:00 AM Mass, and the following week we will perform the final scrutiny at the Noon Mass. The Scrutiny process is a ritual celebration of the action of the Holy Spirit who strengthens and purifies the hearts of the elect in their preparation for reception of Baptism and the Easter Sacraments. The scrutiny Prayer each week corresponds with the Sunday Gospel for these weeks in Lent.

Here are some excerpts: The first scrutiny prayer corresponds with the Samaritan Woman who Jesus met at the well: "Grant that these Elect, who like the woman of Samaria, thirst for living water, may turn to the Lord as they hear his word and acknowledge the sins and weaknesses that weigh them down."

The second prayer involves the gospel of Jesus healing the man born blind: "Stir up the desire for good in these elect, whom you have chosen for your sacraments. Let them rejoice in your light, that they may see, like the man born blind whose sight you restored, let them prove to be staunch and fearless witnesses to the faith,"

The third calls the elect to the fullness of life in the Spirit reflected in the raising of Lazarus from death to life: "Through your Spirit, who gives life, fill them with faith, hope, and charity, that they may live with you always in the glory of your resurrection, for you are Lord forever and ever."

Participating in the RCIA is much more than going to classes on Catholicism. It's undergoing a conversion to a new way of life in Christ. Although doctrinal instruction is a part of the formation process, the formation of disciples is a process that involves the prayerful support of the entire worshipping parish community. Each year we enlist parishioners to be sponsors, and persons on the journey with those who will receive the Easter Sacraments. This year we have more candidates for baptism and reception than we have sponsors. Next year we hope to engage more support through the Stewardship process so that the parish community may benefit from the process of conversion that is enhanced with broad participation in the process. We ask that all of us pray especially for the 17 RCIA and RCIC candidates who will be receiving sacraments at Easter. This is a holy and important time for them and for us as a Parish. May God, Bless them deeply in Loving Care and Protection.

Japan Earthquake/Tsunami Relief March 11, 2011

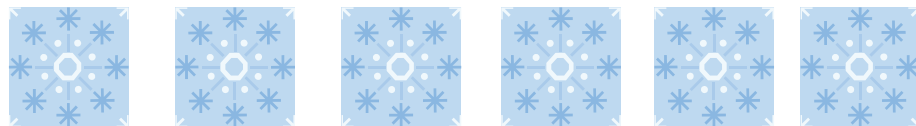
The Archdiocese has learned that there is a desire across our Archdiocese to make contributions to relief efforts in solidarity with the people of Japan. To assist this process, Sharelife is willing to accept donations from parishes, where the parishioners wish to support the relief efforts.

If you wish to support these efforts, Sharelife asks that you **do not** use Sharelife envelopes. They ask that you use plain envelopes, so not to be confused with the 2011 Sharelife Appeal which has started. Please mark your name and amount on the envelopes, along with your offertory envelope number, so you get credit on your tax receipt. Please mark the envelopes "**Relief for Japan**". Cheques should be made payable to the St. Joan of Arc-Sharelife and marked Earthquake relief. The parish will then forward one cheque to the Sharelife office.
