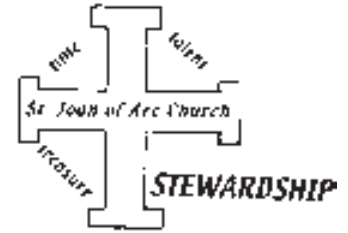

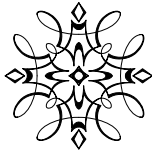

THE PASTOR'S CORNER

Today, Palm Sunday, we remember Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem as we carry our palms in procession for the gathering to hear the passion gospel. Once again we remember the long and mournful story of His betrayal, mock trial, unlawful conviction, condemnation to death and burial. We listen and recall the persons and events surrounding the passion and death of the Lord.

Today, each of us is invited to identify our own place in the story. The characters are familiar; Judas the betrayer, Peter, who denied him, and wept bitterly in remorse, His disciples sleeping in their prayer, the Priests and scribes, Herod and Pilate all failures in their leadership, the angry crowd hungry for blood, Simon a reluctant helper with the cross, the women weeping at injustice, two guilty criminals hanging at his side, a centurion who recognized His innocence, Joseph of Arimathea who generously gave his tomb, the faithful women who saw to his burial, and yes, Jesus himself, pouring out His love and forgiveness to the last breath. The procession is our own walk to remember the story of our Salvation, God's love poured out on the Cross for all.

Today we begin the Holy Week celebrations that take us through the events that form us as a Church. We are united in the memory of how deeply we are loved and embraced unconditionally by God in Christ Jesus. The Easter Triduum is the high point of the Church's celebration. This begins on Holy Thursday with the Lord's Supper, is followed by the Triumph of the Cross on Good Friday and the Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday. This experience is one liturgy that takes us to the Easter Season of life in the Risen Lord. We invite you to gather for the Triduum Celebrations and hope you can participate fully in the Holy Mysteries that the liturgy provides. We will be truly blessed by God in this experience.

I want to thank the many ministers, choir members, RCIA participants, Lectors, Eucharistic Ministers and all who are working to prepare the celebrations. Your dedication and stewardship of the parish is demonstrated so beautifully in these events and I am grateful to God and to you that I may serve as your pastor in this holy season.
