Stewardship starts young. Children who are raised to care about others grow into adults that do the same. Last Saturday, a group of our members from St. Joan of Arc youth group gave up their Saturday night to help homeless youth in Toronto! Not only did they give up their time but also their money to do this. They walked a 5K on the Queensway for The Coldest Night of the Year. On top of their money they also raised funds to donate. And while it might not have literally been the coldest night of the year, I was certainly proud to see St. Joan of Arc represented. I think we can all learn from their example of self-giving and I hope they have learned from our examples! To all those involved, keep up the good work.

We met this week with those who bring communion to the homebound in order to coordinate our Pastoral Care Ministry. We are fortunate to have some folks who are helping us coordinate this. Over the past months we have been asking those who take communion to let us know who they are so we can have a list of those in need. This is especially important because when a pastoral minister was unavailable, through sickness or some other reason, people were not being attended to and we don't want anyone to think they are forgotten. Soon, we will be asking for others to help in this ministry, so that it doesn't become a burden for any one individual. As my father always said, "Many hands make's the burden light." We are happy that we have a couple of parishioners who have had training by the diocese for this and are willing to share their learning. What we hope for is that those who bring communion to others will be our eyes and ears, so that we know how they are doing and if they need confession or anointing. They are already our hearts and hands showing the compassion of the community at St. Joan of Arc. We say that "All are welcome" but for those who can't always join us this is a wonderful way to live that message.

I know it has been snowy and cold but keep the warmth of God's love in your hearts and share it with others, like our youth and pastoral ministers do, so that the reach of St. Joan of Arc Parish spreads far and wide the goodness of God in his care for us and our care for others.

Ash Wednesday, March 6

This is one of the two days in the church year (the other is Good Friday) when healthy persons between the ages of 18 and 59 are asked to observe a day of fast and abstinence. This consists of having one full meal (with no meat) and up to two other meals which, taken together, do not equal a full meal; no snacks in between and no meat at any meal. We are asked t be sensible with regard to specific conditions. A construction worker, a person with diabetes or a nursing mother would not be expected to rigidly follow this precept. Observance of it is the church's way of helping us to be aware that we are entering a time of a more somber preparation of our hearts for the full celebration of the Paschal Mystery at Easter. Abstinence on other Fridays in Lent is a matter of personal, voluntary discipline, recommended but not required by the church. If we are not abstaining, we should be replacing it with some other personal discipline.
