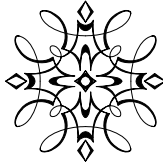

Peace and Goodness to all!

This fourth week of Lent Sunday is called Laetare Sunday (rejoice) because it marks progress in the Lenten discipline. Some of you may remember when the priest wore rose coloured vestments on this day as on the third Sunday of advent. (It is still done in some places). This week the gospel from John, focuses on Jesus healing the man born blind, and marks the second of the three scrutinies celebrated in the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults. RCIA. This week the scrutiny will be included in the 10:00 Sunday Liturgy, and next week at the 7:00 PM Mass. The reason we stager the schedule of these rites is so that the entire parish can participate in the program throughout the Lenten journey.
