

This message first delivered by Mary Magdalene to the disciples of Jesus proclaimed the Good News that transforms the whole world, bringing hope and substantial joy to all generations. The Church continues to celebrate the experience of Easter and the message of Jesus, the resurrection and the life for all to believe. This season we have much to celebrate with the recent election of Pope Francis. In him we have been given a leader whose prophetic disposition bears witness to the new life we proclaim in the Gospel. 
