



The Friar's Nook

The Easter is the most luminous, joyful and hopeful time of the Liturgical Year.

The joy of Easter does not respond to an annual cycle, nor to the good weather or awakening of nature, but to the news that underpins the Christian faith, the resurrection of Jesus Christ, once for all.

Christians on these holidays exchange a familiar greeting: "Happy Easter!" In some communities the expression is more explicit: "Hallelujah, Christ is risen!" And the answer is: "Truly he is risen, hallelujah! Which is the same as saying: "Rejoice! the Lord is risen." Jesus' request to his Father, before dying, was: "May they have my joy fulfilled in themselves" (Jn 17, 13).

An Easter text reveals very well the reaction of Christians, who, like the Apostles, after having suffered accompanying the steps of the Passion of Christ, it may be difficult to smile again.

The Gospel points out a very curious reaction in the disciples: "Just as they could not believe it because of their joy and were astonished..." (Lk 24, 41). The joy is so deep and unexpected that nature takes time to accept the event, although slowly the truth of the news embraces the entire being, floods it and gives it the ability to overcome all barriers. It is the experience of the two disciples of Emmaus, when they reflect and share the warmth they felt inside while Jesus explained the Scriptures to them, although they had not yet recognized him.

Jesus had told the disciples: "You are sad now, but I will see you again and your heart will be glad and no one will be able to take your joy away from you" (Jn 16:22).

The first Christians were flooded with Easter joy, so that those who observed them were amazed at the love, unity and joy they manifested. The Apostles "went to the Temple every day with perseverance and with the same spirit, they broke bread from house to house and ate food with joy and simplicity of heart." (Act 2, 46).

In spiritual discernment, a principle is consolation. Easter allows us to taste the sweet taste of the desired presence, and even if the Lord is not seen, faith grants the certainty of the embrace of the one who in many ways reveals himself in the hearts of those who wait and trust.
