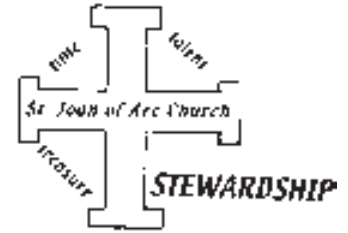

Thursday evening, Cathi Richardson, Larry O'Grady and I met for the second time to make progress on the photo gathering for the parish directory.

We are hopeful that we will have everything submitted soon to the Life Touch Company so we will have the completed books after Easter. Thank you all for your patience in this process. I will keep you posted.

Saturday morning the Liturgical ministers gathered for our semi-annual retreat to pray and prepare for our Easter Celebrations. Sheila Malloch developed a different format to assist us in affirming the gifts we have been given and to help others to recognize their giftedness. Thanks to Rose Di Tommaso and Rosanne Kelly, also for their behind the scenes support and to all of the ministry leaders for gathering the troops.
