

## THE PASTOR'S CORNER PEACE AND GOODNESS TO ALL!

This weekend we celebrated our Mardi Gras dinner dance thanks to the generous ministry of our Social Committee. Their love and dedication to the parish made this sold out event a great one to remember. We thank them all for making this such a wonderful success, and thank you to all who came out to enjoy this festive occasion for the parish.

Ash Wednesday is upon us this coming week and so together we join the Church throughout the world in the period of prayer, fasting and almsgiving that characterize the discipline of Lent. Together we will walk with the Lord Jesus who fasted and prayed forty days in the desert to prepare him for the ministry which led Him to the Cross of our Salvation and to His glorious Resurrection that is our Easter hope. This is a holy time of renewal for us as we contemplate the liturgical offerings given through the Holy Scriptures provided in the Church for this season. We pray that the Holy Spirit will inspire and empower us to grow more deeply connected to the Lord Jesus Christ as faithful followers in the way of the Cross.

Many individuals participate in attending daily mass during Lent. The Stations of the Cross will follow the Friday evening masses and will be led by various organizations of the parish. We will be engaging our liturgical ministers and parish coordinators in a retreat on Saturday, March 26<sup>th</sup>, so that we may grow together on the journey. This will continue the process begun during advent as we continue to deepen the Spiritual dimensions of our parish Stewardship. We hope to make progress in articulating our Parish Mission statement as we continue on the journey together through the Cross to Resurrection in the Pascal Mystery of Christ.

The RCIA Lenten retreat will be held on April 2, and will be conducted by Sr. Elizabeth Losinski. Sheila Malloch will engage the children in the RCIC preparation through their program. Together the community will celebrate the various Rituals and Scrutinies through the Lenten Liturgies. Let us pray for the 17 individuals who are engaged in these processes. The RCIA and RCIC programs are wonderful signs of our growth and spirituality. Please keep them in your prayers throughout this holy season.

The finance committee met this week to discuss and plan for the ongoing financial health of the parish. They noticed that there is a bit of a downward trend in the offertory, but reasoned that this might be off-set because there have been contributions to the building maintenance fund. We have received a bequest that is to be used as a matching fund for any donations that are given to building maintenance. Hence any donations you make to the building fund will be matched in the coming year. Already the building committee has drawings of the storage facilities that they will oversee maximizing our capacity and creating new storage space that will blend into the current décor of our meeting spaces. The finance committee and the building committees are both dedicated and professional groups who contribute much to identify and meet the needs of the parish. We thank them and we thank you all for your generosity of time talent and resources.

We have much to be grateful for. God is so good to us in calling us to serve the Church. May God be glorified and praised in all of our lives and relationships.

#### Ash Wednesday

This is one of the two days in the church year (the other is Good Friday) when healthy persons between the ages of 18 and 59 are asked to observe a day of fast and abstinence. This consists of having one full meal (with no meat) and up to two other meals which, taken together, do not equal the full meal; no snacks in between and no meat at any meal. We are asked to be sensible with regard to specific conditions. A construction worker, a person with diabetes or a nursing mother would not be expected to rigidly follow this precept. Observance of it is the church's way of helping us to be aware that we are entering a time of a more sombre preparation of our hearts for the full celebration of the Paschal Mystery at Easter. Abstinence on the other Fridays of Lent is a matter of personal, voluntary discipline, recommended but not required by church precept. If we are not abstaining, we should be replacing it with some other personal discipline.
