THE PASTOR'S CORNER

For several months the Pastoral team has been consulting with liturgical experts to plan ways we might enhance our worship experience, grow our community and hopefully to attract young people to become part of our worship experience. We have contacted local high school teachers, talked with our confirmation preparation leaders, and discussed ways that we might best develop our worship experience to satisfy the broadest base of parishioners and perhaps engage new persons of all ages to become involved in our worship.

We decided that it is important to work on one area at a time and it seemed the best area to begin to focus our efforts would be in the area of Liturgy and Music. This area engages the whole community and can be a clear reflection of what we are about as a worshiping Church.

Beginning at Easter time we will engage, Christian McConnell PhD, a professor from St. Michaels College of the University of Toronto to work with us in growing the liturgical music experience of the parish. He will be working with all of our musicians and choirs to develop our liturgical experience and to help us to grow our music ministry to enhance our worship and draw us into deeper engagement in the sacred mysteries of the Liturgies. This will be a process in which we hope to grow our choirs, interest the youth of surrounding schools, and enhance the worship of the Church.

The Vatican II documents on Liturgy instruct us that Sunday Eucharistic worship is the source and summit of the life of the Church. It is our faith in this truth that has led us to take this current direction toward building our Community of Faith and Worship. We hope in this way to grow our vibrant parish to be all that God wants us to be as a reflection of the Kingdom of God in the midst of our City.

On Sunday March 21, we will gather after the noon mass for our annual Ministry Sunday to plan our Triduum Celebrations. This will be an opportunity for all of our ministers to meet Christian. This will also permit us to plan further steps we can take this coming year to grow our commitments and engage all of our ministries in the Stewardship of our Liturgical worship.

Please pray that our efforts will be blessed by the Lord and that we will draw many to know and Love the Lord more deeply through the liturgical life and worship at St. Joan of Arc Parish.

May God Bless us richly in this our Lenten journey through Paschal mysteries and the holiest season of Easter.
