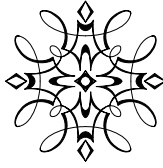

The great gift of life that our mothers have given to each of us is the greatest one that makes all other gifts appreciable. Thank you to all of you and may the Lord fill you all with choicest blessings on this your special day.

Saturday, we celebrated the First Communion of 60 of our young children. What a lovely and wonderful event that celebrates new life and profound relationship with Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament for these children, their families and the Church.
