

The Feast of the Ascension celebrated today focuses on the mystery of Jesus ascending to the Father to prepare the Church to receive the Holy Spirit. The experience of the disciples in their relationship with the Risen Lord is completed as the Advocate the Paraclete, continues the mystical revelation of God's word and Sacramental presence in the Church. Next Sunday we will celebrate the feast of Pentecost, when we remember the story of the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the disciples and the birth of the evangelical mission of the Church.

She will be assisting in the transition for next year's programs which we will present to the parish in the coming weeks, please stay tuned.
