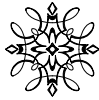

From the Desk of Rosanne

*Since we were very visible last weekend,
I thought I would give you a little of our history!*

This year the Archdiocesan Council of the Catholic Women's League is celebrating 90 years of service to God and Canada. There are many facets of the league that one can participate in. Such as the following convenorships: Spiritual Development, Christian Family life, Education and Health, Communications, Legislation, Organization and Resolutions. Each one communicates with the next level, going from parish, region, archdiocese, provincial to national. Our national executive meets once a year with the Federal Government presenting the concerns of our members to them.

St. Joan of Arc's council has just celebrated its 46th Anniversary in January. You can check the CWL wall in the meeting room and see the list of Presidents and Spiritual Advisors we have had over the 46 years. Thanks to these people, our league has survived.

Over those 46 years we have sponsored many activities, Seniors Clubs, fashion shows in our parish hall using our own members as models and being able order the outfits right here in our own parish hall and out; and in the Eaton store downtown. We co-sponsored New Year's Eve Dances in the parish with the Knights.

We purchased vestments, amplifiers, contributed to the original organ, the cupboards in the meeting room. The stain glass window that is behind the choir was purchased to commemorate our 20th Anniversary. We have purchased tables and chairs and the room divider for the parish hall.

When it was allowed, we held a citizenship court here in our own hall, and during the ceremony, it was so hot, that the RCMP office on duty fainted, and slid right down to the floor. Later, when they didn't allow these ceremonies outside the court, we hosted receptions at the Citizenship Court for the new citizens.

Over the years, we sponsored emergency courses, and babysitting courses, not to mention Blood Donor clinics that started back in the 1980's. After a rash of break ins, we helped pay for the alarm system. We shared the cost of purchasing the new organ and purchased the commercial fridge and paid to have the stove repaired.

To celebrate the 75th Anniversary of the parish we hosted a fashion show on a Sunday afternoon, with the theme from "The 1920's to the 1990's."

Back in the 1980's, one of our pastoral associates' asked if the league members would make baptismal bibs and stoles. (Two of our members still make them.)

Each year our council financially supports parish and neighbourhood charities. We presented the parish with \$10,000.00 to go towards the new kitchen in the hall.

We participate in Regional and Archdiocesan days of Reflection and are well represented at the Archdiocesan Convention each year.

Active membership is open to all young ladies 16 yrs of age and up, upon payment of membership fees. Associate membership is open to non catholic women 16yrs and up, with the exception of not having voting privileges.

Our council meets on the 4th Monday of each month, September through April. Most members are active on the parish level, but if interested can go up to the Regional level and stand for election on the Archdiocesan, Provincial and National levels.
