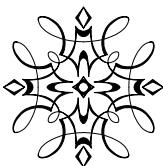

Pentecost Sunday comes 50 days after Easter to celebrate this feast that remembers the miraculous descent upon the disciples of Jesus, with Mary the Mother of Jesus in their midst. It is often called the birthday of the Church as it is the feast that remembers the special day when the Holy Spirit came down upon the Apostles in wind and fire to empower them for the mission to evangelize the whole world for all time.
