THE FRIAR'S NOOK

One Hundred Years ago this week, St. Joan of Arc Parish Church was founded and established on the site of the what is now the Dundas West subway station. In 1967 five years after the Vatican II Council, our current building was designed and built to conform to the pastoral directives that emanated from this important gathering of the Magisterium of the Church. It was the first such established and has been an inspirational gathering place of beauty and Holy Spirit filled worship ever since.

The building was designed to gather the Holy People of God in a space that invites full participation in the Eucharistic Celebrations as the source and summit of our faith. The Community of St. Joan of Arc has been known from the beginning, as a welcoming parish dedicated to living the Gospel to demonstrate the life of Christ. Under the guidance first of the Sacred Heart Fathers, a warm loving and prophetic culture was developed. Then for the past 22 years, the Franciscan Friars of the Atonement, working with the lay leaders of the parish further developed the community of Faith to engender a spirit of Gospel Stewardship.

The Charism of the Franciscan Friars of the Atonement took root in this parish which was fertile ground for practicing the hospitality which invites the great diversity of parishioners to become united in giving witness to the Body of Christ. This is represented poignantly in the life and worship in Eucharistic celebration that gathers us to hear the Gospel proclaimed, be nourished at the Lord's table, and to go out to live and proclaim the good news of our experience of Christ in the community.

Our Parish Mission to live and proclaim the Gospel and to welcome all to celebrate with us continues to thrive and be renewed even today as we rejoice in 100 years of gathering as a Catholic community. This year, our parishioners are poised to work with the Holy Spirit as we commit to revitalize and reinvigorate our commitment to Christ and the Gospel as we plan for the future, The Friars with our Ministries and Finance Committees will guide us to build an ever more deeply inspired involvement in realizing the mission of the Church in all that we are and do.

We will hold meetings through the summer months to plan and develop our strategic efforts to enhance Gospel Stewardship. Our hope is to invite and integrate all of our parishioners to participate ever more fully in the life of the Church in the Stewardship of our time, talents and resources, for the Glory of God the Good of our neighbor, and the Salvation of All. Let us pray that our future will continue to reflect the grace that God pours out so abundantly upon our parish.

This week we remember in a special way, Sr. Elizabeth Losinski, NDS. who passed away on May 22nd. Elizabeth worked with this community from 1989 through 2009 as a great spiritual leader and guide especially in our RCIA program. May she rest in Christ's Peace and pray for us as we remember her in our prayers. Elizabeth deeply touched many lives in her dedicated service to the parish.

We give Glory to God for the past 100 years, and we ask that we may go forward for many more years: Living and Proclaiming the Gospel through Stewardship welcoming all to know, love and serve God with all that we are, have and do by His grace and guidance.
