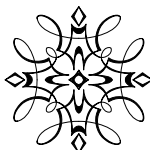

PEACE AND GOODNESS TO ALL!

The feast of Pentecost has been celebrated from the earliest days of the Church as a remembrance of the phenomenal event that brought the Holy Spirit and Power upon the disciples. They who were living in fear and apprehension were transformed into heralds of the Gospel for every language race and nation. By the power of the Holy Spirit they were given every gift that Jesus bestowed upon them so they might continue his life and ministry of service to all humanity by their healing, preaching, forgiving sins, and serving the poor of God.

It is the Birthday of the Church that has continued this ministry down through the ages and is manifest in manifold ways, both institutionally and by the work of individuals who practice what the Church traditionally called the Corporal and Spiritual works of mercy. This includes caring for the sick and aged, feeding the poor, clothing the naked, lodging the homeless, extending council to the sorrowing, sick and outcast of any kind. This Sunday we will also baptize two of our RCIC children who were unable to be here at the Easter Vigil. We praise and bless the Lord who brings us so many gifts of life and vitality.

You will notice that the lighting in the Sanctuary is about completed. Thanks to John Kelly and Ozzie Moreal for their willingness to complete this work. May God Bless them richly. Other efforts by the building committee are also in process, and we thank them for their dedicated service.

The RCIA sessions for this year will be ending next week, and we will begin a new session in September. If you or anyone you know is interested in becoming a Catholic, please have them telephone the office anytime over the summer.

Thank you for your patience with the annual financial report. It was completed weeks ago, and will be distributed this weekend in the bulletin. The Ministries Committee will meet next week to complete the Parish Survey and discern the best time to conduct this in order to receive the most qualitative response. This committee will be working with me to strengthen our Stewardship resources throughout the summer to prepare us for next season.

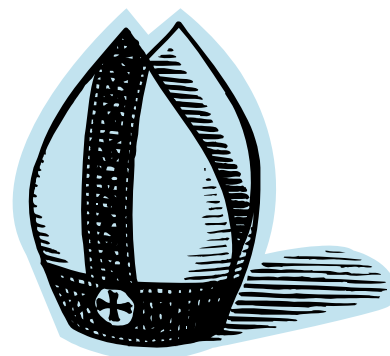
