The Friar's Nook HAPPY PENTECOST!

Today we celebrate the day that is known as "the birthday of the Church." The Holy Spirit was sent to all the disciples to carry the Good News out to the world. The disciples did their part and the news of Christ spread throughout the world. But that work is not done. It now falls to us, who are empowered by that same Holy Spirit, to spread the Good News. We're not all called to be missionaries to bring the news too far away lands, but we are called to bring the Good News to the corners of the world, the corners of our life, that we reach.

We have been empowered by the Holy Spirit, who continues to work in and through us, to be ministers of the Good News of Jesus. It's encouraging to me to see our Sunday crowds growing in number. And no doubt you've seen the number of baptisms on the upswing. So, we must be doing something right! As our numbers grow and as summer approaches it will be more and more difficult to find ministers for the Masses on Saturday and Sunday. As it is, we frequently don't have enough ministers for a particular Mass, sometimes there are no ministers for Mass! Since the COVID pandemic, our finances have been in the red. But I am less worried about our finances then I am about our ministries. With an increase in numbers attending Mass, it should follow that we have an increase in ministers for the Masses. So, I'm asking you once again to think about how you can help in our sacramental ministry. As it is, you already come to church, so why not participate in a ministry?

I do believe that our finances will rectify themselves if we ourselves commit to the parish and show that commitment in full and thriving ministries. As it is there are ministries that I would love to see established that I haven't started up yet because we don't have enough people to do what we already have. I would love it if we had sacristans for the Masses who would take care of coordinating the setup for each Mass and make sure the ministers were in place. I am hoping to start up a bereavement choir. This would be a group of people who would be emailed when there was a funeral coming up to see if they could sing together at the funeral. Since funeral music is pretty specific, they wouldn't need be need for weekly rehearsals, simply arriving an hour before the funeral to go over what was being sung. This would be a great service to those who have lost a loved one to see the parish support and it would certainly help for those who have not been to church to have someone respond to the prayers rather than me saying "the Lord be with you..." only to have silence follow.

Please pray about this and let the Holy Spirit work in you for the greater good!


