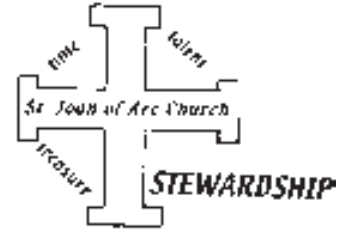

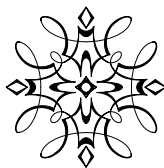

THE PASTOR'S CORNER

Peace and Goodness to all!

Wednesday of this week the Church celebrated the feast of St. Joseph the Worker. It is a day we promote the dignity of human labour which was raised up in the life of Jesus, who was taught carpentry under the fatherly care of St. Joseph. It is a time when we also pray for those who are without employment that they will sustain hope and faith as did St. Joseph in the trials that he endured as he served God as the protector and provider for the Holy Family.

This past week the Archdiocesan level of the C.W.L., held its annual convention concluded by an annual banquet. It's the first one I missed in the past five years, and they let me know I missed a great meal because of a schedule conflicted with the Finance committee meeting on Tuesday evening. The finance committee assists and advises me in financial human resource and sometimes legal matters for the parish. We have a gifted and dedicated membership on this committee. Some of the members are coming to the end of their terms and so we are searching for qualified individuals from the parish who might step forward to serve. On May 2, Frank and Carmen Grech celebrated their 60th anniversary of marriage. We prayed especially for them at the 5:30 Mass, with gratitude for their many years of Christian witness through their marriage and family life. Frank and Carmen are deeply committed members of Joan of Arc Parish, whose dedicated service behind the scenes exemplifies the spirit of parish Stewardship. Many of you have received the cards and notes they send as parish "Scribes" which are completed with my signature as pastor. In this and other ways they generously serve the Lord in the parish. We pray in thanksgiving for Carmen and Frank, and also for their family. They bring many blessings to us as a parish.

This week we celebrated First Friday with the monthly anointing of the sick after the 5:30 Mass followed and adoration of the Blessed Sacrament and Benediction. It is such a joy to see so many come forward to receive this sacrament and to pray together in Christian witness to our faith in the Eucharist. We welcome all who participate in these celebrations with gratitude to the Knights of Columbus representative, Ray Gallagher who leads a communal recitation of the rosary before Benediction.

This event sponsored by our parish gardening and building committees is always a great day for us to spruce up the gardens, and the grounds for the summer months.
