Rosella is a First Nations elder from the Wiikweemkong First Nations on Manitoulin Island. She is a DOS, which is a Diocesan of Service to the Catholic community on the reserve. She is the administrator for Our Lady of Grace Parish, one of the four parishes in Wiikweemkong. Recently, she has been asked to be part of the Canadian Council of Bishops to help with the dispersing of funds to FNMI over reparation for Indigenous peoples across Canada who have been affected directly and generationally by residential schools.


Bible Study
