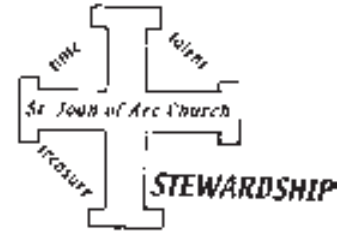

FROM THE DESK OF ROSANNE

The Society of St. Vincent de Paul

The Society of St. Vincent de Paul started in 1833, when Frederic Ozanam and a group of students from the Sorbonne University were challenged to prove their faith in Christ through action, not just words. They accepted this challenge and the Society was formed, working with the desperately poor in Paris. Developing a simple system, they went in teams to help the poor in their homes the streets, the hospitals and in asylums.

This work is continued today worldwide, following that tradition of small working groups, known as conferences. A conference is parish based, such as St. Joan of Arc's Conference. Parish based Vincentians provide the fundamental unit which enables them to serve those in need through person to person contact. Emergency assistance is given by way of food, clothing and furniture, managed through a voucher system.

Levels of the organization: National, Provincial, Archdiocesan, Particular & Parish.

What do we do?

- As a society we support Marygrove Camp. This residential camp is a fully subsidized programme for girls 5 to 13 yrs of age, located on Georgian Bay near Penetanguishine, 1,200 girls attend the camp each summer. Each conference registers girls for camp each year.
- All conferences hold Bundle Weekends to collect gently used clothing and small household items that can be given free of charge, through our voucher system in our stores, to those in need.
- Prison Apostolate & Court Services: Provides support and clothing for persons awaiting trial or in prison, and assist them in maintaining contact with their families
- Twinning with other Conferences: A partnership of aid to the needy Conferences and Councils in Canada and overseas.
- Residential Programmes: Women's Emergency and Transitional Housing programme provides housing and support to women in crisis through a network of emergency beds and longer term housing at Mary's Home, St. Clare's Residence, Amelie and Eliza House.
- St. Francis Residence: a home for 24 men and women who have experienced mental illness and are unable to care for themselves without support.
- Ozanam House: Provides transitional accommodation and support for men recently discharged from a detox centre and awaiting entry in to an addiction treatment programme.
- VincePaul Community Homes: provide men and women recovering from addiction with the support and encouragement needed to build a new life. We have 12 homes located in the Metro area.
- DePaul and Vincent House: Offers residential care and support for 12 men and women who are developmentally handicapped. They live in a loving community, learn basic life skills and share in basic decision-making processes.
- St. Joan of Arc belongs to Toronto West Particular Council, which has 14 conferences; boundaries are the Humber River to the west and Yonge St. to the east.
