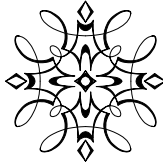

The Pastor's Corner
Peace and Goodness to All!

Today, we celebrate All Saint's Day. It is a great time to consider the call of every one of us, as Christians to become a Saint. Saints include all of the deceased who have been living icons of Jesus Christ in their lifetimes in the contexts of the opportunities and challenges that their lives presented for them to live the Gospel. The canonized saints of the Church have had their life stories examined and these have been told in the wonderful biographies that make up the lives of the Saints for the Church. Our faith presents the hope that there are innumerable saints whose lives have not become publicly acknowledged, but who none the less have lived as exemplary Christian Witnesses, drawing others into relationships of salvation in the Lord Jesus Christ. In my own life, I can think of several individuals who have been inspirational figures of prayerful holiness and generosity of service for others that have helped me to understand what life in Christ is all about. A couple of Friars with whom I have lived and worked, a few family members and friends, some parishioners or associates of missions I have served, come to my mind as individuals whose saintly lives most probably place them among the Saints who we celebrate in this great feast. My bet is that most of us can recall saintly people in our circles of family and friends. Today we celebrate their lives in Christ in a special way.

Tomorrow we will celebrate All Soul's day. Here we remember all the deceased who we pray will be among the saints by merit of the Death and Resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ. We remember all of the deceased members of our families, and circles of friends just the way they were. We remember as well as all people of good will with the confident hope that the Lord will take them to Himself. These feasts celebrate what we pray daily in the Eucharistic Prayer as we ask God to remember all who have died marked with the sign of faith and all whose faith is known to God alone. What a marvelous blessing we have in our traditions that are grounded in the Incarnation of Christ, Son of God and Son of Mary. May the Lord bless us all richly in this gift of Faith that grounds our hope in the Love of God!

This past Friday the youth group sponsored a family fun Spooky Halloween night. Halloween of course comes from the abbreviation of "All Hallow's Eve" the eve of all Saints. The silly Halloween fun we have that has developed over the centuries with ghosts and goblins and all sorts of costume parties comes a long way from its roots in the Saints, but it's good to remember where it all came from. I remember in Catholic School we were always encouraged to dress as one of the Saints. Usually as with our youth night, this option was rarely chosen, but we always had good fun with this, and I want to thank our youth for the wonderful evening that we all enjoyed on Friday. May God continue to bless them for all the good service they bring to our parish!

May the Lord bless us all, that we may become the Saints we are called to be as Christians!
