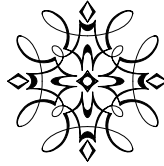

What a gift it is to host this wonderful witness to Catholic Education in our church. We give thanks to Almighty God for the grace of their worship and presence.

Last Sunday the Catholic Woman's League Bazaar brought great fun to the parish after all the Masses, what a blessed gift the CWL brings to our parish, much thanks to Maria Caprara for her leadership of so many dedicated members who made this possible. Sunday afternoon, I was present as one of the many interfaith readers in the Ecumenical and Interfaith prayer service at St. Paul's Basilica for all throughout the world who are persecuted for their faith. Fr. Damian MacPherson, SA director of the Archdiocesan office of Ecumenical and Interfaith Activities hosted this event which brought together representatives of over 20 faith traditions for the first time in Toronto History.

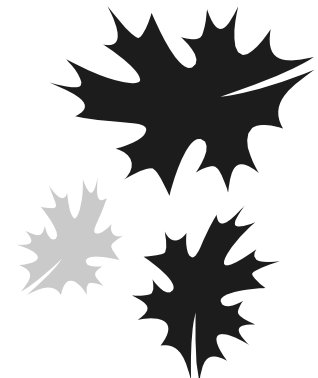
