

The Parish Council gathered on Tuesday evening to review the new parish website design. We will also be calling up volunteers for the Winter Welcome Table in the coming weeks as the dates for our participation in this outreach were reported.

Wednesday, I attended the gathering of many of the priests to discuss the Archdiocesan Pastoral Plan that is developing over the next couple of years. Several of our committee members have participated in this process that will help to sustain the life and vitality of the Catholic Church in Toronto.


