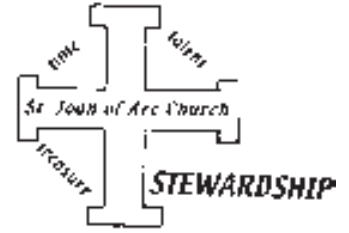

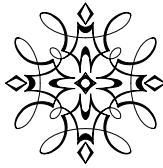

We were blessed to have the students and faculty of Marrocco Merton High School here on Monday to celebrate a Mass for Justice and Peace in observation of Remembrance Day. The Parish Council gathered on Tuesday evening to review the new parish website design. This has already been implemented with the Wednesday night gathering in conjunction with the RCIA program. We are already planning ways to meet some of the other suggestions raised in this survey. Following these presentations reports were given by various committees to keep us apprised of their activities. Watch the bulletin, because the visit of St. Nicholas at our Sunday masses to help the St. Vincent de Paul Society is coming up soon. We will also be calling up volunteers for the Winter Welcome Table in the coming weeks as the dates for our participation in this outreach were reported.

Wednesday, I attended the gathering of many of the priests to discuss the Archdiocesan Pastoral Plan that is developing over the next couple of years. Several of our committee members have participated in this process that will help to sustain the life and vitality of the Catholic Church in Toronto.

Please remember the Advent/Christmas Ecumenical Lessons and Carols that will be held here on December 7.
