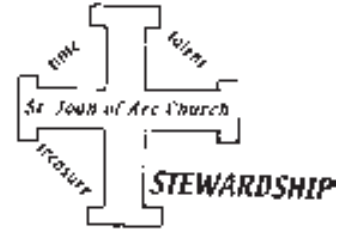

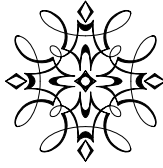

Friday we celebrated the monthly anointing of the sick as a part of our monthly First Friday celebrations. It is always inspiring to see so many come to receive the Sacrament of the Sick.
