Throughout the month of November we at St. Joan of Arc parish remember our deceased loved ones with special attention given during the All Soul's Novena beginning on the feast day of Nov. 2. This special Feast and time of remembrance professes our faith in the Lord Jesus Christ, whose life death and resurrection has purchased eternal salvation for all who believe in Him. The great Communion of Saints celebrates the whole body of Christ with all of the Saints in Heaven, the faithful departed souls of those who have died marked with the sign of faith, and we who continue on the pilgrim journey here on earth, guided by the Word of God, the Holy Spirit, and the Sacramental Life of the Church. Gathered as we are as members in the Body of Christ, with the Lord Jesus, the first born from the dead, the head and the Capstone of our redemption, we live in joyful hope for ourselves and our departed loved ones throughout our spiritual journey through life to the Kingdom of God for which we are destined by the grace of God's loving plan of Salvation. Praise the Holy Trinity!

A word of thanks goes to all who have contributed to the Iron Friar campaign which has provided the production and installation of our new signs. We hope you enjoy these new additions to our building. The replacement of the worn out St. Joan of Arc sign includes the image of our patroness, taken from the stained glass window inside the office entrance which is rarely noticed because of its location. The welcome and reminder of our dedication to stewardship are incorporated into this sign because of the priority we place on these values for our community. The other sign just outside the office includes several interchangeable panels of stained glass photos to depict the liturgical seasons of the year. We will be able to include the mass and reconciliation times on placards that will also be able to be changed for the Christmas and Easter variations as time goes on. This sign was purchased with some of the funds from the Iron Friar campaign, and was supplemented by a legacy bequest from Kazmiera Sienkiewicz. May she rest in the peace of Christ.

We are working on creating the commemorative plaques for these signs as well as the one for bells that were purchased last year's Ironman campaign. The names have been submitted to the company and so we are waiting for them to be produced together. These will be positioned with the others posted from the previous year when we fixed the stained glass windows. Thank you all for your generosity that makes these little improvements possible.

Thank you to all of you for the stewardship of the parish life, worship and community that you sustain by your faithful commitments to St. Joan of Arc Parish. You make me feel proud to be your pastor.
