THE PASTOR'S CORNER Peace and Goodness to all!

Wednesday evening the First Communion class of 2018 gathered with their parents and the catechists to begin this year's program. It is always a joy to meet these wonderful families who bring their children to receive this marvelous Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist. Indeed this is the source and summit of our faith and to see this gift being transmitted into the next generation gives us great hope.
