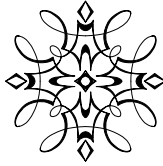

The parish finance committee met this week to review our finances and discuss the needs that may arise in this current season. It was noted that we had a slight increase in revenue 1%, which fell short of the 2.5% we were hoping for to meet the increased expenses that will be incurred now that we have both a pastor and an associate pastor salary to meet annually. They mentioned that we have consistently budgeted for these two salaries, which account for the deficits that are reflected each year. This year however this could impact the end of year actual numbers on the balance sheet. They are planning on addressing this matter in early December with the community. This group is comprised of well credentialed professionals and we are deeply grateful for the advice and expertise they bring to the administration of our parish.

The Rite of Christian Initiation has begun with it opening topic recognizing the central role of the Sacred Scriptures in the life and worship of the Church. We are continuing to welcome new members to this program, so if you or anyone you know is interested in becoming Catholic or learning more about our faith, we meet at 7:30 in the Parish meeting room. Please call Fr. Dan or the Office to become enrolled.

At the Staff meeting this week, we discussed the many programs and matters that are unfolding in this busy time of year and we are very glad to now have Fr. Bob Langone with us to help us grow in servicing the needs of the parish in our many ministries and organizations. We had a very spirited and enthusiastic meeting and are delighted to have him with us. His many gifts and talents are augmented by great enthusiasm, holiness and a fine sense of humor. No doubt you have already experienced this in meeting him. The Lord has blessed us with his presence.

This week, I will be going to Nottawasaga for the annual priest gathering there, they will be discussing Stewardship as a way of being Church for the whole Archdiocese.
