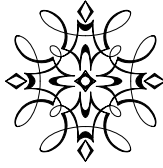

It may have just been the two of us, but you are with us in prayer and thought.

I know as a country and as a people we choose a day to celebrate Thanksgiving, but I hope as Christians that we offer thanks to God every day. I'm sure there are a lot of people who think Thanksgiving is about stuffing themselves and watching football. For me, it is always been about family and being grateful. Sure, I love the food, in fact Turkey dinner is one of my favourites, but I know that's just a very small part of our being together. It's the sharing at table, or should I say tables, as when my family gathers there are sometimes up to 70 people. It's a great time to catch up on everyone's lives, face to face and not online. We're trying to get back to some sense of normalcy this fall, but things are very different. As I mentioned in the announcements, we are looking for help for the Winter Welcome Table. This is a ministry whereby we feed the homeless on Mondays from November through the spring. Since we can no longer provide a sit-down dinner, we will be handing out dinners from Saint Peters on Mondays from 5:30 to 6:30 PM. This is a completely volunteer run ministry and so we need your help. Because of Covid-19 they will not be in contact with those who come for a meal. The kitchen crew will be kept separate, those packaging the food will be kept separate, and those handing out food will be kept separate, to keep everyone safe. The city of Toronto has cut back on programs for the poor and homeless so the need for meals is especially important this year.
