

FROM THE DESK OF ROSANNE

World Mission Sunday, October 24, 2010

Listed below are the principal works the World Mission Sunday Collection supports:

- *to train and support catechists;
- *to provide education through schools, colleges, universities, some seminaries;
- * to build rural health clinics.
- *support specific diocesan pastoral projects.
- *to use mass media for evangelization.
- *to provide emergency aid to refugees and aid to disaster areas.
- *to Safeguard the livelihood of missionaries and local clergy.
- *to train local religious and establish housing for them.
- *to open new missions and help to establish new dioceses.
- *to assist people of the poor communities to build decent structures for prayer and community gatherings.

Every year in May national directors from around the world meet in Rome to approve projects submitted for specific projects. Financial support is allocated to countries for specific projects. The money is sent directly from the Canadian National Office to the Country of the approved project. The money does not go to Rome. 2009 Contributions from English Canada were a total of \$233,750.00.

The Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops Pastoral Mission Fund helps mission countries on all continents with grants, primarily in programmes for faith development, missionary formation and catechetical training.

Some of the 2009 moneys were distributed to Ecuador, Tanzania, Thailand, India and Papua, New Guinea. Tanzania's funds supported 7 dioceses, building churches, chapels, convents, rectories, repairing parishes where needed.

In Thailand, 7 churches were built, a convent and a chapel. Heat was provided for a community catechetical centre. 3 churches were reconstructed and another was completed. Training and formation provided in 10 centres for catechists and parish leaders.

In India, formation and training was provided in 16 centres for catechists, parish leaders and pastoral programmes. 26 churches were constructed, 15 chapels, 4 convents and 12 rectories, as well as 2 Pastoral Centres.

In Papua, New Guinea, we helped 7 dioceses, constructed a church and 4 chapels. We also, renovated 10 churches, 5 rectories and a conference centre for the diocese. Solar energy for 5 missions was installed.

The balance sheet for the Propagation of the Faith has been supplied to us and is posted on the bulletin board at the entrance of the church.

The collection taken up everywhere in the world today is given in it totality to support the churches of the Developing World.
