#### THE PASTOR'S CORNER

May the Grace and Peace of Christ fill your life with love and joy.

Our "All Hollow's Harvest Fest" dinner dance tickets were sold out last weekend with over 165 tickets sold. Please accept our regrets if you were unable receive a ticket. This is a great success, and a great show of our community spirit. This is the last event we will be able to have that won't need to be modified because of the impending construction that is due to begin on Monday of this week. If your organization has any materials in the cupboards or under the stage, it is time to rescue it. Otherwise it will be disposed of as the immediate situation presents itself. Thank you for your understanding and patience. As it stands, all of the construction is scheduled to be finished by the middle of February 2010, as outlined in the plans presented this week. We will continue all of our programs and activities with adjustments to the space requirements as we go along. Again, thank you for your patience and perseverance.

It has been a busy week here at St. Joan of Arc. Monday night at the Parish Council meeting, we further discussed the redesign of the council and walked through the importance of continuing to gather representatives of our many organizations and we decided that we would continue this mode of operating on a quarterly basis, even as we work to structure a representative council that will bring the number of members from the current 29 to perhaps 8 members. This is a work in progress we hope to have refined for the next meeting.

On Tuesday the Finance Committee met and laid out its many tasks and plans. The terms of reference and structural outlines for organization of all of our financially related committees were delineated and will be implemented by the next meeting. This format will better integrate the Capital Campaign, Parish Council and Administrative aspects of our parish along the Canonical and legal lines that are recommended. We are closing in on the figures that delineate the income against the expenses of running the parish and it is quite clear that we are running at a deficit, even given the reduction in staff that the parish has experienced over the past two years. To remediate this a program designed by the Archdiocese for increased offertory giving will begin in November, and will be lead by the finance committee members. Please be attentive to this program as the fiscal health of the parish will be dependent upon total cooperation by all of us.

The telephone system repairs were completed yesterday, hence there should be no more dropped calls. This problem was caused by the electrical system difficulties which should be resolved in the progress of the Capital Building process that is underway.

Next week the Archbishop will be here to celebrate the 10:00 Mass, we are so privileged to have his eminence here to celebrate our 90<sup>th</sup> year in existence as a parish. Please arrange to attend this mass if you can, it would be great to have a full house for the celebration. We will have a coffee and cake gathering in the hall following this liturgy.

As you can see we are engaged in many improvement and growth related concerns as a parish at this time, and we thank God for his many blessings upon us. I thank you as a parish for your whole hearted involvement and generosity. It is a joy to serve you.
