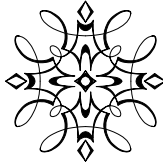

Bob this past week to be share in the Archdiocesan commitment to become more engaged in this way of being Christian. On December 1, the whole parish community is invited and encouraged to attend our semi annual retreat that will remember our dedication to this Spirituality that binds us all together by virtue of our Baptism in the Lord and our remembering that the Eucharist is the source and summit of our life as a Church that is fully engaged in the Stewardship of time talent and resources that God has given us to fulfill our call as Christians.
