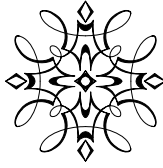

THE PASTOR'S CORNER

Peace and Goodness to all!

All Saint's Day and All Soul's Day, Nov.1 and Nov 2 are important days in the Church calendar. They Celebrate the Communion of Saints who represent the destiny of Salvation that awaits us all. This past week we celebrated three funerals here in the parish. Each gathering was as unique as the individuals whose lives we celebrated in the Mass of the Resurrection. In these we express our certain hope that for the faithful; in death, life is changed not ended. Each gathering of family and friends in these masses brought the opportunity to thank God for the lives of these baptized Christians. We believe they have entered the heavenly Kingdom of God to be among the Saints whom we celebrate in the coming festivals. Our prayer for the deceased helps us to remember our solidarity and shared destiny in the Communion of Saints. In this destiny, we already share, as persons baptized into the death and Resurrection of the Lord. The Communion of Saints by definition includes the Saints in heaven, the souls in Purgatory and the Faithful living on Earth. We are together in the journey to God's eternal Kingdom in the mysterious and wonderful way that has been mapped out for us in the way of the Cross. Jesus walked this for us to teach us; that He is the Way, the Truth and the Life. We are all to follow in the unique journey in each of our lives. As we celebrate All Saints Day and pray our All Souls Novena, we bring this aspect of our faith into focus to strengthen our Faith, ground our Hope in Christ and grow in Love for God and one another.

All Hallow's Eve, is by origin, the night before all Saints Day. It is indeed a celebration with deeply Christian roots and significance, even if it has been distorted by the mystique of a commercial world. It is fun to see the children dress in their costumes and play their tricks or treats. The funny Jack O'Lanterns and decorations on our houses speak a spooky set of silly fears. Shadows, webs, and scarry forms. These suggest the mysteries of death as the fearful thing it is for many. But we as Christians know that we can laugh at this; because we know in Faith, that in Christ we pass through the door of death to the eternal life that Jesus won for us. Ours is the Paschal Mystery. This ground of our faith is so beautifully celebrated in the two feasts of the Communion of Saints. How wonderfully they illustrate for us the festal gathering that awaits us all as Christian Believers.
