


The Society of St. Vincent de Paul

The Society of St. Vincent de Paul started in 1833, when Frederic Ozanam and a group of students from the Sorbonne University were challenged to prove their faith in Christ through action, not just words. They accepted this challenge and the Society was formed, working with the desperately poor in Paris. Developing a simple system, they went in teams to help the poor in their homes, the streets, the hospitals and in asylums. This work is continued today worldwide, following that tradition of small working groups, known as conferences. A conference is parish based, such as St. Joan of Arc's conference. Parish based Vincentians is the fundamental unit which enables them to serve those in need through person to person contact. Emergency assistance is given by way of food, clothing and furniture, managed through a voucher system.

Levels of the organization are: National, Provincial, Archdiocesan, Particular and Parish. What does the Society do?

- As a society we support Marygrove and Ozanam camps. These residential camps are fully subsidized programmes. Marygrove is for girls and Ozanam is for boys, ages 5 to 13 years of age. Each conference can refer these boys and girls to these camps. (Closed in 2020 due to covid-19)
 - All conferences hold Bundle Weekends to collect gently used clothing and small household items, that can be given free of charge to our clients, using our voucher system in our stores.
 - Prison Apostolate and Court services provide support and clothing for person awaiting trial or in prison and assist them in maintaining contact with their families.
 - Residential Programmes: Women's Emergency and Transitional Housing programme provides housing and support to women in crisis through a network of emergency beds and long-term housing at Mary's Home, St. Clare's Residence, Amelia and Eliza house.
 - St. Francis Residence: a home for 24 men and women who have experienced mental illness and are unable to care for themselves without support.
 - Ozanam House: provides transitional accommodation and support for men recently discharged from a detox centre and awaiting entry into an addiction treatment programme.
 - VincePaul Community Homes: provide men and women recovering from addiction with the support and encouragement needed to building a new life. We have 12 homes located in the Metro area.
 - DePaul and Vincent: Offers residential care and support for 12 men and women who are developmentally handicapped, they live in a loving community, learn basic life skills, and share in basic decision-making processes.
 - St. Joan of Arc belongs to Toronto West Particular Council, with conferences covering boundaries between Yonge St. to the east and the Humber River to the west.
- We can't shut down, during Covid-19, our neighbours in need, require our help with food vouchers more than ever. We will be holding a Bundle Weekend November 14 and 15th.
- Thank you for your continued support of our poor box, we appreciate the continued donations during this difficult time.
