# The Friar's Nook

WELCOME BACK! I HOPE YOU ALL HAD A GOOD SUMMER.

We have been busy getting things ready for an exciting new year. Hopefully by the time you read this the new air conditioning will be complete. We have replaced the four units on the roof (two of which were dead) with energy efficient units and added temperature sensors around the church so the temperature should be more comfortable. In replacing the units, we found the seals connecting them to the ducts had deteriorated after 30 years leaving 2-inch gaps up on the roof. This had some effect on the cooling but much more in the winter when the warm air from the church was just leaking out. I am looking forward to lower gas bills this winter.

The biggest thing that we have done though is hire a Parish Manager, Marie-Joyce (or MJ as she likes to be called) Ramos. This is a big step in our growth as a parish. She will be responsible for Parish communications i.e. the website, the Facebook page, the online calendar, the You Tube page, the parish app (yes we have a parish app!), the bulletin, etc. She will also coordinate technology, administration, and event management. Her first big project will be managing our Stewardship and Volunteer initiatives.

MJ was born and raised in Montreal. She is fluent in English, French and Tagalog. MJ has a background in Early Childhood Education and taught French in a pre-school & kindergarten. Her work as a lay missionary with 'Couples for Christ' took her to Africa and Eastern Canada. She has plenty of experience working with kids, youth ministry and young adults organizing events, conferences and volunteers. MJ has a passion for parish life and is looking forward to getting to know you and to be an important part of St Joan of Arc's vibrant community.

She has already started to work on youth and young adult ministry so keep your eyes and ears open in the coming months. She claims to be really good at karaoke, so I've suggested we do some fun nights in the hall as was done in the past, things like talent nights, ethnic nights, etc. Things to have some family fun and help us to get to know each other better.

I am excited to see our continued growth this fall. I hope that you will help us grow!




