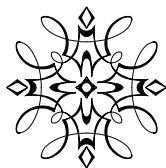

Don't forget to inform the parish office of your new address, so we can update our files.

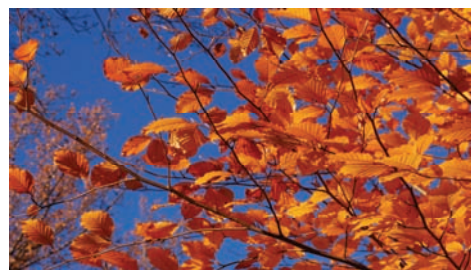
Please don't tape your envelopes
