This greeting that I use each week for this article, is the Assisi Greeting remembering St. Francis who always greeted everyone with Pax et Bonum, or Pace y Bene in Italian. Now, I write this overlooking them majestic Umbrian Valley from our house on the hill behind St. Clare's Basilica here in Assisi. It is sunny and cool. I have had a wonderful 8 day retreat here in the Novitiate where I was present as a General Council member to receive Paulo Nicosia NSA into the Franciscan Habit, and to enjoy the Papal visit "Assisi 30, 1986-2016, Thirst for Peace", remembering the anniversary of the 1986 gathering of more than 200 world religious leaders from many different faith traditions who gathered here to pray for peace at the call of St. John Paul II.

The last time I was here was to be engaged in an other retreat to prepare for my priesthood ordination It ended on the world day of prayer that is was remembered now by Pope Francis, His most holiness, Bartholomew the patriarch of Constantinople, the Archbishop of Canterbury and other dignitaries. The Dali Lama was here thirty years ago and was present again for this celebration, as a much older man. What an uplifting experience it was to be engaged in the Ecumenical and Interfaith day of prayer. It is fitting that we as Franciscan Friars of the Atonement could be present for the event.

You all were very much in my prayers. For you and the parish as I was mindful of the Stewardship Weekend that we will once again celebrate this weekend, with the certain hope that the Holy Spirit will guide us once again to be fully engaged in the life and ministry of St. Joan of Arc Parish dedicated to Living and Proclaiming the Gospel and Welcoming All to love and serve the Lord and one another in the mission of the Church.

We are so blessed to have so many deeply committed parishioners who bring the gospel to life in our relationships to bear witness to our Faith in Christ Jesus. This for me has been a time of spiritual renewal and refreshment and I look forward to my return Thursday to be present for the Sunday Liturgies. I can't wait to tell you all about it. Thank you again to all of you for your prayers and enthusiastic engagement in the life of the parish. You are a blessing to me and to the Church of the Archdiocese of Toronto.


