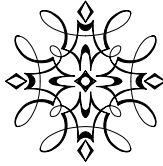

Peace and Goodness to All!

Our Stewardship Weekend last week was a great success! Thank you to all who participated whole heartedly in this annual re-commitment to our parish ministry and mission. Our motto: "We proclaim and live the gospel through Stewardship, All are welcome", was once again re-affirmed and strengthened by your commitments to serve the parish by your generosity in sharing your time, talent in service to the community. We had 71 volunteers who came forward to augment the service organizations and ministries that make our parish a vibrant place of worship and service to the community. Thank you to Cyndy O'Grady whose leadership as stewardship coordinator helped to orchestrate this important event. Thank you also to Rosanne Kelly, and Anne Francis and Vivian Kwok, members of our parish staff who worked diligently behind the scenes to encourage full participation in this effort. Parish organizations like the CWL, St. Vincent de Paul Society, and Development and Peace were as ever, present to provide support and encouragement to the parish effort. Special mention to Rose Di Tomasso who canvassed the community to discover new greeters and individuals who will assist the new volunteers as they become involved in our ministries. The Stewardship prayer that we recite each Sunday is realized through your generosity and life giving service. Thank you and may God Bless you all!

This Sunday the parish is encouraged to participate fully in the Archdiocesan Family of Faith Campaign this is one of the most important phases of this capital campaign effort and is called "Commitment Sunday". This part of the program calls for enlisting everyone who has not already contributed, to consider making a pledge to help us to reach our \$505,000 Goal. The sacrificial giving process began over the summer months and has continued to this point where we have now reached 60% of our Goal. Thank you to all who have so generously contributed to this important campaign. Most of you have been contacted by letter, telephone calls or requests to consider making pledges that can be met over a 5 year period to assist us in the archdiocesan campaign to build the Church for the future and to contribute to our own parish. Our portion will go toward repair of our stained glass windows and repairs to our walls and other infrastructure that have aged considerably since 1967, when the building was built. Our website provides a qualitative link to the Archdiocesan Family of Faith materials. The details provided there explain fully the program plans and projects, and I encourage you to discover this, if you are not already familiar with its contents. For those who do not have access to computer resources, there are packets available at the parish office or at the back of the Church. On Commitment Sunday we will provide you with pledge cards and pencils to make your pledges and submit them either to the collection basket or to the office at a later time so that they may be sent to the Archdiocesan office for collection. All of the parishes in the Archdiocese have participated in this program, most of our neighboring parishes have already reached or surpassed their goals. It is my hope that we too will have a successful campaign. Let us pray and ask the Lord's assistance in this important endeavor and I thank you all for the generosity and sacrifices you make that will help us reach our goal. May God Bless you abundantly in every way.
