# A Brief History of Our League

St. Joan of Arc's Catholic Women's League will be celebrating 56 years of Service to God and Canada in January 2021. Over the years, we have sponsored many activities and groups. We once had a club called "Do As You Wish", it then changed to the "Over 50 Club". We hosted a few fashion shows as fund raisers. We had one at "Eatons" downtown, and the other two were at the parish, with our members modeling outfits that could be purchased by those in attendance and the third one was for our 75th Anniversary of the parish with the theme "The 1920's to the 1990's".

One of the associate pastors asked us to make stoles for the babies that were being baptised, this practice continued until about 2018 when a parishioner took over.

Over the years we sponsored Emergency and Babysitting courses. We hosted receptions for First Communion and Confirmation classes.

In 1999, the parish had a rash of break ins, so we contributed to the first Alarm system, we shared in the cost of purchasing the new Organ. We purchased the commercial fridge, tables and chairs for the hall and the room divider. Our official CWL Banner is placed by the altar and we form an honour guard for our members at their funerals. Four of our members made a second banner for our Council and it hangs in the parish hall.

Each year we hold a bazaar, (not sure if we can this year due to Covid 19). Funds raised at the bazaar help financially support our parish and neighbouring charities.

We take part in Regional and Archdiocesan activities, such as Days of Reflection and the Convention. We have had our members go on to be on the Regional and Archdiocesan Executives.

Would you like to be a member? Active membership is open to girls starting at 16 years of age upon payment of membership fees. Joining the League is a great way to get involved in your parish and make new friends.
