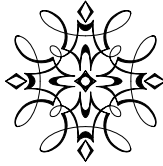

Monday the youth group gathered again for the first time this year to begin setting their agenda and activities. Monday evening the Catholic Women's League gathered at the 5:30 Mass and proceeded to their season opening meeting.
