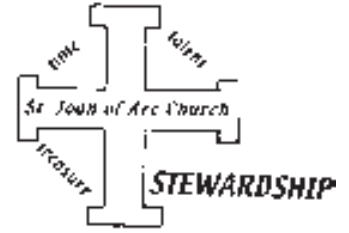

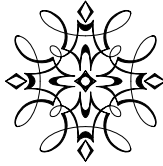

**THE PASTOR'S CORNER**

Peace and Goodness to all!

The first reading in today's Eucharistic Liturgy recalls the way that Moses delegated the work of the Lord on 72 leaders in the Jewish faith community in his time. Certainly he was exercising the Spirit of Stewardship for the people of God even in his time. This speaks to us of the same Holy Spirit that permeates our parish ministry as we share the burdens and responsibilities of our parish among so many of our organizations and committees. There are several individuals who have begun the inquiry stages of the RCIA, The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults. If you or anyone you know is interested in becoming Catholic, please let them know that we will continue to accept candidates for this program until Advent. Once again thank you to all of you for your participation and stewardship of our parish life and ministry. May God Bless the work of our hands!
