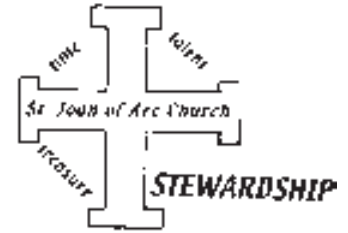

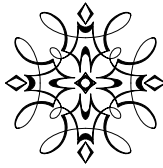

A relic of St. Don Bosco is coming to Toronto. It will be on October 5th at St. Benedict Church, 7:30 am – 11:30 pm.
