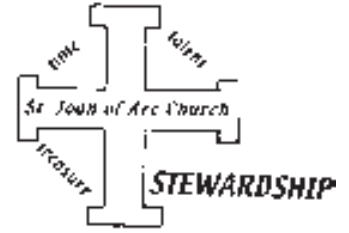

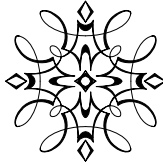

Welcome back to all who have been away for the Summer Holidays and welcome to all visitors, new parishioners and anyone who may be attending our parish for the first time. We are glad to celebrate the return of our Choirs and those who participate in our Sunday School classes. Another season begins today and we ask God to fill us with the Holy Spirit so we may truly celebrate the Word of God and the Eucharist with all our hearts and minds throughout this year.

Today we are beginning a two week survey process at all of the masses, in order to gather information from all of you to help us grow in our service for all at St. Joan of Arc parish. We hope we will be able to enhance our life, worship and stewardship efforts so all may be fully engaged in the parish as we move forward throughout the liturgical year. Thank you for your participation and patience in this process, we are confident that the effort we put into this will help to direct our growth in Christian life and worship as a parish. We express our gratitude to the Ministries Committee for developing this survey and for the analysis they will complete to guide our growth and development, may God bless the work of our hands.

The Building committee met this week to re-focus on the work that will need to be accomplished in the coming year. This committee has many projects outlined for this coming year. We will keep you informed of the details of their progress as it continues. Thanks to the work of this committee our facilities continue to be maintained and improved by their work and guidance. We are arranging for a member of this group to become a standing member on the finance committee so that communication and monitoring of our progress will be an ongoing part of the process.

We had our first staff meeting of the season this week, welcoming Sheila Malloch our director of religious education back from summer holidays. This week after Labour day, we had much to cover as our activities begin in full measure. Thank you for your prayers for us as we continue to serve your needs. We are seeking teachers and assistants for our religious education programmes, please see Sheila if you feel called to this ministry.

We will begin the adult bible study and religious education programme with an open house gathering on September 19. These sessions will involve an hour long teaching each week on Wednesday evenings at 7:30 beginning on September 26th. All are welcome to attend.

Following the class those who are involved in the RCIA program (the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults) will continue for another hour to discuss the meaning of these teachings for their personal journeys in conversion. Full explanation of these programs will be provided at the open house on the 19th of September. All are welcome to attend.

In past years we provided the complete series of teachings to the RCIA candidates, with knowledge that these classes would benefit all Christian Adults, and so this year we decided to open the instruction portion of the program for the benefit of all

Then those who are interested in becoming Catholic can remain to process the meaning of these teachings for their personal faith development. If anyone would like to become a sponsor or to journey with the RCIA candidates, they are also invited to participate in the second hour of the classes.

If you or anyone you know is interested in becoming a Catholic either through adult baptism or reception of the Easter Sacraments, please call me and/or come to the open house on the 19th of September.

We begin this season, full throttle, with the survey leading up to Stewardship Weekend on Sept. 15 and 16 with the hope to engage all into the life of the parish.
